FINAL 100 DAYS OF THE YEAR OF THE DRAGON Until February 9

This collaboration between the ArtScience Museum and the family-owned Kraemer Gallery of Paris showcases rare 18th century French Asian-influenced furniture. This furniture display is the first in Singapore and was curated in commemoration of the Year of the Water Dragon. A highlight of the exhibition is an exceptional Louis XV pedestal clock (circa 1754) decorated with dragons made by King Louis XV's exclusive cabinetmaker Jean-Pierre Latz and master clockmaker Michel Stollenwerck. marinabaysands.com
